### Pommery Brut Royal, NV

£68.0

The colour is pale yellow with faint green highlights. This is lively, fresh, delicate and generous. Citrus fruit and white flower notes combine with small red fruits to offer elegance balanced with great finesse and complex finish.

### Lacourte- Godbillon Terroirs D'Ecueil 1er Cru Brut, NV

£86.0

Light and lively, with red fruit and citrus freshness. The palate is fresh and concentrated, fine textured, with flavours of ripe white stone fruits and a delicate acidity.

### Pommery Brut Rose, NV

£98.0

Delicate pale pink with fine and persistent bubbles, very subtle rose character, supple and finely robust with appealing freshness and liveliness.

### Charles Heidsieck Brut Reserve NV

A full bodied fizz with class, tasting panel with its ripe, biscuity aromas, mature fruit and lively acidity.

### Charles Heidsieck Brut Millesime '2013

£205

The bouquet of the 2013 Brut Millesime is compellingly fresh and minty, complicated notes of white fruits-notably pear and apple-citrus and gentle spices, as well as a light touch of smoke.

On the palate this is a structured, tension filled but airborne champagne with racy acidity, fleshy and charming texture and long penetrating finish.

### Taittinger Comtes de Taittinger Blanc de Blancs '2011

With a tight and composed palate. Its full bodied with a racy mid palate. Long and persistent. Very structured with phenolics and acidity. Minerally, floral refreshing and energetic too.

## Rose Wines

### Grenache, Journeys End Wild Child Rose '2021

£52

A pale pink colour with a fruit forward nose. Elements of strawberry and cherry blossom on the nose with a flinty mineral finish.

### Vallado Touriga Rose '2019

£68

A very nice rose, it has quite a pronounced red fruits and berries nose and also on the palate, with some herbaceous touch. Rest long mouth and is quite different than Provence

# WHITE WINE

- Pinot Grigio, Alois Lageder Porer '2020** £48  
Rich in body with a lot of tension. Fresh and Fruity with lemon and peach flavours, and a touch of spice and minerality.
- Cortese, Monte di Sarocco Cavi di Gavi DOCG '2021-2022** £49  
This wine is light and fresh with hints of lemon and grapefruit on the palate and a long, mineral finish  
An elegant crisp dry white wine made from cortese grape that were grown on the hillside of Piedmont region.
- Riesling, Charles Smith Kung Fu '2020** £50  
A lively number with tonnes of character, this wine is bursting with delicious stone fruit and citrus notes, with a subtle minerality on the palate.
- Jacquere, Apremont Cuvee Gastronomie Jean Perrier '2020** £52  
Family owned producer grows mostly indigenous grapes in the various crus throughout the alpine of savoie.  
Yellow apple, fennel and lemon. Zest notes, with lively floral notes on the finish.
- Vermentino, Primo Bianco Di Sardegna -DOC '2022** £55  
Pale straw color with aromas of fresh citrus fruits and apricots. On the palate, the wine is zesty and fresh with crisp, clean finish.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Greywache Marlborough '2022** £59  
This Sauvignon has smart zesty aromas with lime. A hint of passion fruit and a mouthwatering salinity, very elegant minerality.
- Chablis, Domiane Jean Defaix '2022** £60  
A classic Chablis : bright and refreshing with notes of citrus green fruits very complex and fruit driven .
- Chardonnay, Macon Solutre Pouilly De.Trouillet '2020** £62  
This Chardonnay has aromas of red apple, lemon curd, stone fruit and brioche.  
Very intense and has very acidity and a long finish.
- Chardonnay, Journey's End Destination '2020-2021** £67  
Full of citrus, melon and pineapple fruit flavours, with well integrated, toasty, vanilla notes. A full bodied softly textured wine.
- Bourgogne Chardonnay Les Murelles Domaine Roux '2020** £70  
A Rich style of white wine with aromas and flavour of lemon, apple and brioche.  
A creamy mouthfeel is balanced by good freshness.
- Riesling, Robert Weil Rheingau Trocken '2020** £80  
Charming, fruit driven dry Riesling with perfectly integrated acidity. Sleek and elegant with white peach, nectarine, zesty lime, soft apple blossom and the slightest touch of creaminess in the texture.
- Sauvignon Blanc, Ch.Guiraud Bordeaux Blanc '2019** £84  
Intense and complex with tangerine, grapefruit, peach and gooseberry. Aging on the lees lends a rich texture to a long, fresh finish.

- Chablis 1er Cru, Vosgros Domaine Gilbert Picq et Fils '2020** £97  
Delicate floral aromas, classic minerality, zesty, fresh citrus and with some of the hallmark chablis honey character coming through with age, full flavoured and powerful.
- Clairette, Chateauneuf du Pape Blanc Domaine Grand Veneur '2019** £114  
Complex and elegant, with ripe stone fruit aromas, fresh citrus fruit, Vanilla spice and a touch of jasmine, it is creamy and smooth with yet great minerality and a long finish.
- Clairette, Gerard Bertrand Art de Vivre, Occitanie '2019** £140  
It has an elegant straw yellow colour, decorated with green highlights that reflect its youth. The palate is fresh, elegant and harmonious.
- Riesling, Weingut Robert Weil Trocken GG '2020** £160  
Complex, intense and elegant, with fresh citrus and stone fruit aromas, floral hints and steely minerality. The finest dry wine the estate has to offer which will continue to age and develop.
- Chassagne-Montrachet les Chaumes Domaine Roux '2020** £164  
Mature, complex and sophisticated with depth and character ripe yellow and green fruits, good spice and a touch of blossom.
- Louis Jadot, Chablis Grand Cru Blanchot '2018** £185  
With mouthwatering green and citrus fruit, steely minerality and subtle almond hints, this is among the top chablis available. An exemplary balanced complexity.
- Sauvignon Blanc, France, Didier Dagueneau Silex '2014** £299  
Intense, dry with gently smoky and flinty notes, touch of citrus, medium bodied with a complex dry finish.

## RED WINE

- Frappato, Italy, Nerollo Mascalesa '2021** £42  
The wine has a aroma and flavours of jammy red fruits, summer herbs and a touch of violet. On the palate it is rich, yet juicy and refreshing.
- Buio Rosso Carignano del Sulcis DOC-Mesa '2022** £44  
The aroma of the wine from Sardinia is determined by all kinds of red fruits, very elegant withn all dryness with finest balance.
- Negresco Valtenesi Rosso DOP-Ca Maiol ' 2019** £52  
Fruit driven wine with a complex minenerality , on the palate the texture of this punchy red wine is wonderfully silky, melting, velvety and dense.
- Gran Dominio Rioja Reserva '2015** £54  
This wine is ruby red in colour with aromas of bright red fruits complemented by vanilla and spice notes from the oak, rich on the palate with a long finish.
- Ch.Marchand Montagne St.Emilion '2019** £60  
An elegant wine, with ripe but fresh fruit flavours. On the palate, the wine is very round with soft and well matured tannins. While approachable and ready to drink upon release.
- Merlot, Brazil, Miolo Lote 43 '2018** £66  
A structured, full bodied wine with intense aroma's and flavours of plum, tobacco, truffles, cocoa and clovewith complex savoury notes.
- Nebbiolo, Angelo Veglio Barolo '2018** £70  
A crown pleasing introduction to the Nebbiolo grape. This Barolo has aromas of cherry, rose and orange a medium weight with ripe yet juicy red fruit cherry like flavours with soft tannins.
- Chateau Peyrabon Haut Medoc '2011** £77  
An expressive nose with smokey notes, ivy leaves and oriental spices. The palate has great freshness, with complex red and black fruit flavour. It is medium bodied, with robust soft tannins and long finish.
- Pinot Noir, Alois Lageder Krafuss '2019 (Biodynamic )** £80  
This Pinot Noir is produced by Italian Biodynamic winemaker, Alois Lageder. It exhibits a pronounced bouquet of fruity red and black cherries, spice, pepper and flintstone. The rich, savoury and fruity flavours compliment the silky tannins in the medium bodied wine.
- Capezzana Vila di Capezzana Carmignano '2012** £100  
Elegant, with notes of red and dark fruit with spicy aromas. Well structured with rich concentrated flavour of currant and wild berries set against a backfrop of silky tannins.
- Pinot Noir, Claude Dugat Bourgogne '2016** £114  
Cool and quite clean with red cherry and lactic notes. Lots of sour plum flavours. Very complex, medium bodied with creamy finish.
- Shiraz, France, Che Blue Heloise '2012** £130  
Inviting nose of red fruit and old teather, seductive taste of vanilla, chocolate and a hint of sandalwood, with long elegant finish.

## **RED WINE**

### **Chateau d' Lssan '2007**

£155

The nose leads with cigar box and dried meat aromas with delicate dried fruits. Bright acidity, medium body with light earthy tobacco character. Plum fruit, and some smoked meat on the palate.

### **Portuguese Blend, Portugal, Qt Vale Meao '2015**

£227

Has a lively colour, floral scents combined with red fruit aromas. Fills the mouth with intense fruit notes, showing a long, very fresh and complex after taste.
